### INSTRUCTIONS FOR SENDING DOCTORAL PROPOSALS

Doctoral students who wish to participate in the CLADEA Doctoral Colloquium must send their proposals considering the following guidelines:

- 1. You must not include your name anywhere on the document.
- 2. The text of the doctoral proposal must not exceed 6500 words (all included: References, tables, and figures). Any document that exceeds this limit will not be considered for the review process.
- 3. The text must be written in Times New Roman 12 font, 1.5 spacing and 6pts spacing between paragraphs.
- 4. All proposals submitted must cover the following aspects:
  - a. Abstract (15-20 lines)
  - b. Research problem and question
  - c. Research objectives
  - d. Literary review and/or concept framework
  - e. Methodology
  - f. Expected outcomes (proposal in preparation) or preliminary findings (proposal in execution)
  - g. Discussion and conclusions
  - h. Bibliographical references

### ON THE TOPIC OF THE PROPOSAL

When saving the files into the system, please consider the appropriate thematic axes:

- Administration and Organizations,
- Economics and Finance,
- Marketing,
- Operations and Logistics,
- Information Technologies,
- Innovation and entrepreneurship,
- Others: must specific the thematic axes which are different from those mentioned above.

# REQUIREMENTS TO PARTICIPATE IN THE DOCTORAL COLLOQUIUM

PhD students interested in participating must have a reference letter from their advisor stating that they are participating in a doctoral program, and it must be signed by their doctoral thesis advisor. It must include: Name of the Institution, name of the doctoral program, name of the doctoral degree to be obtained, Name of the thesis advisor, email address of the advisor.
